

Richey v. Turocy; 1990 WL 1229313, 8 Pa. JVRA 10:2 (1990)

The lawsuit was brought against the hospital, defendant orthopedic surgeon and the physical therapist. The plaintiff alleged that the defendant's physical therapy treatment caused a subsequent heart attack. The defendant hospital maintained that the defendant physical therapist was experienced, properly trained and should not be expected to make a referral outside the scope of the therapy. The verdict was rendered in favor of the defendants.
